Progress since the last WG-SP meeting in December 2021:

Member list was updated and submitted to CCPR executive secretary before 25th CCPR plenary meeting. In addition, WG-SP chair distributed call for experts to WG-SP members in April 2022, and three experts showed their interests to join TG12. Now TG12 consists of 24 experts.

I was informed that the draft TG12 survey report shown in the last WG-SP meeting missed the input from some members. Corrected version of the survey report has been prepared. Now it is in the final check to confirm that nothing has been overlooked. It will be distributed before the next WG-SP meeting on 8 September 2023.

Regarding the future for TG12, unfortunately it is difficult for me to continue the chair of TG12 for some reasons. Considering my continuation as the TG12 chair will cause further delay that is not beneficial for TG12, I've decided to step down from the TG12 chair. In December 2022, call for TG12 chair was distributed to WG-SP members. So far, no candidate for the new TG12 chair hasn't yet identified. I hope TG12 will find the new chair soon and resume technical discussion with his/her lead.

The first task of the new chair in conjunction with all members is to determine the "Term of Reference" for TG12, based on the survey report of the questionnaire about LED-related research activity and collaboration works.
